### **Car:**

The campus postcode is RG6 6UR

Please note that on campus parking is pay-and-display. Roads surrounding the campus have limited free parking and is often very busy. Please consider coming via train or bus if possible.

### **Train:**

Reading train station is a mainline train station and is easily accessible from most other places in the UK.

There are direct rail links from many major cities, including Birmingham, Manchester, Glasgow, Cardiff, Bristol, and Exeter, as well as a number of routes through London.

### **Travelling from London**

If you are travelling from or via London, the quickest route to take is from London Paddington station.

Trains from London Paddington to Reading run approximately every 15-20 minutes throughout the day and the average journey time is around 30 minutes.

### **Bus:**

The 21 and 21a buses run from Reading train station in the town centre to our Whiteknights campus at regular intervals, 24 hours a day.

If you choose to take a taxi or bus, the bus stops and taxi rank can be found outside the station. A taxi will cost you approximately £8 and a single bus journey will cost you £1.90 (return £3.60. You will need the exact money as the buses do not give change).

## **Air Travel:**

Reading is well connected to both London Heathrow and London Gatwick airports.

### **London Heathrow**

A direct bus service runs between Heathrow airport and Reading station. Buses run every 30 minutes, during the day, and take about 40 minutes. For more information, please visit the [RailAir website](#).

### **London Gatwick**

A direct train service runs between Gatwick airport and Reading station. Trains run once an hour, during the day, and take about 75 minutes. For more information please visit the [National Rail website](#).
